- undertaken a NDIS Worker Screening Check
- Completion of: CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability)
 OR
- Completion of: CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability)
- Completion of: CHC30408 Certificate III in Disability PLUS the CHCSS00125 Entry to Certificate IV in Disability Support Skill Set.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS - INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS:

- IELTS 5.5 or equivalent English proficiency
- Evidence of having made a statutory declaration before starting industry placement that they have never:
 - o been convicted of murder or sexual assault; or
 - o been convicted of, and sentenced to imprisonment for, any other form of assault.
- This statutory declaration is in addition to a current national police certificate and NDIS Worker
 Screening clearance, as these contemplate only those convictions recorded in Australian jurisdictions.
