How is this course trained and assessed?

Training has been designed to be progressive and step-based to provide the skills and knowledge required to enter a managerial level career in Project Management in wide variety of industry sectors. Training and assessment is conducted face to face in the classroom as well as through hands on practical sessions undertaken in a simulated workplace environment. All students are required to attend class a minimum of 20 hours per week over the forty-four (44) study weeks. All training material is available to students 24/7 on the Federation Academy LMS. All assessments are submitted and assessed via the LMS.

All training and assessment material is provided to the student through a Learning Management System and all assessments are submitted and assessed through the Learning Management System. Ongoing trainer support and training is provided by direct face to face contact with trainers and assessors thought out the training products delivery. Each trainer is also contactable by email to help students. Students are expected to undertake up to ten (10) hours per week of Self-Directed Learning to improve their understanding of any topics being covered.
